

How to use One-Day Park Hopper® Guest Tickets

Guide for eligible Operating Participant/Corporate Alliance employees located at the *Walt Disney World*® Resort

If you're visiting the *Walt Disney World*® Resort Theme Parks with Guests using your One-Day *Park Hopper*® Guest Tickets*, there are some things you need to know in advance:

- **Please note, visiting more than one theme park per day at the Walt Disney World® Resort is unavailable or subject to limits.** For further information on Park Hopper® privileges, go to <https://disneyworld.disney.go.com/guest-services/park-hopper/>.
- One-Day *Park Hopper*® Guest Tickets are valid for one (1) day of Guest admission.
- Enjoy the flexibility that comes with using your One-Day *Park Hopper*® Guest Tickets. They can be used together on one visit or individually on multiple visits, and you may admit Guests individually throughout the same day.
- The eligible Operating Participant/Corporate Alliance employee must be actively employed by their Operating Participant/Corporate Alliance company and be present to accompany Guests using One-Day *Park Hopper*® Guest Tickets.
- One-Day *Park Hopper*® Guest Tickets are used in conjunction with the Operating Participant/Corporate Alliance employee's self-admission.
- One-Day *Park Hopper*® Guest Tickets can be found online at CompAdmission.disney.com where they can be viewed or printed.



Employees must obtain a reservation for theme park entry in advance. You will need a *My Disney Experience* account, as this is where your *Walt Disney World*® Resort plans are stored and managed. Here are a few important details for using Disney Park Pass System and how to redeem your reservation at the *Walt Disney World*® Resort Theme Parks:

- 1 Log-in to *My Disney Experience* on a computer or mobile device. If you don't already have a *My Disney Experience* account, create one and log in. This is where you will manage all of your plans and admission media. Any Disney Resort reservations can be linked in your account as well.
- 2 The Disney Park Pass System is available in the *My Disney Experience* menu on MyDisneyExperience.com. Each member of your party must have valid admission linked to them in order to proceed with making a reservation.
- 3 Employees and/or their Guests using their One-Day Park Hopper Guest eTickets will need to convert your eTicket to a card at a Theme Park Ticket Window before or on the date of your reservation, if each ticket is not linked to a Magic Band or card.
- 4 During your scheduled arrival window, head to the park's Main Entrance. Use your Self-Admission Pass and One-Day *Park Hopper*® Guest Ticket(s) that were used to make the Disney Park Pass reservation.
- 5 As the Cast Member/Employee, you must enter first by touching your Self-Admission Pass to the main entrance touch point.

Your One-Day *Park Hopper*® Guest Tickets are subject to Company designated block-out dates. Company designated block-out dates may change at any time, and Employees are responsible for checking updated information prior to their Disney Theme Park visit.
